## Why MOLLE is a not always the Best Idea for External Vest Carriers

- In an altercation with a suspect, the suspect can grab a MOLLE pocket and easily tear it off your body. That situation would leave you minus a taser or ammunition and would put it in the hands of a hostile suspect.
- For most departments a MOLLE set up looks too aggressive and “military-looking” for their community. Our vest maintain a less aggressive appearance
- Making a vest carrier with MOLLE strappings is the same cost as making you a vest with custom made pockets. So you would have to pay for a vest with MOLLE strappings and then pay \$8 to \$30 more per pocket to make your vest functional. The final cost per vest can be as much as 70% more.
- Sometimes for officers in specialized units, MOLLE is a good idea because the officer has to carry different items for different situations. In this instance, consider a partial MOLLE set up, see below:
